

BioMedic Application Review Process

The Process

On receipt of student applications, the application forms are reviewed by the Program Coordinator to ensure all parts are submitted.

After the closing date, each application is assigned two (2) Reviewers* (a primary and a secondary) and one (1) Reader†. The applications are then forwarded to the reviewers and readers.

Each reviewer applies a score, based on several criteria, as can be seen on the reviewer form.

When the review committee meets, each application is dealt with on an individual basis. The primary reviewer summarizes the application to the group. The secondary reviewer adds any additional points. If appropriate the reader also comments. This is followed by a group discussion. The group then reach a consensus score.

Following the review meeting, the application scores are compiled and ranked by group (PhD or MASC). Those with the top scores are the ones that will be offered a place on the BioMedic program. Note: the number of offers may vary from year to year, dependant on available funding.
